2019 Photo Contest

To celebrate Whatcom Water Week 2019, the Whatcom Watersheds Information Network (WWIN) is hosting a photo contest open to all photographers. The theme is "Water – It's Everybody's Business," and we are looking for images that convey the role that water plays in your life and in the culture of Whatcom County. Photographers are encouraged to be creative and include water in all its forms.

Contest Categories

- **Favorite Water Spot:** photos showcasing your favorite place to watch the sunset, see salmon spawn, view eagles and other wildlife... you know... the place you like to go and hang out!
- **Working for Water:** photos showcasing how water supports our economy or how you use water in your business ... it's also how you work to protect or restore our water resources.
- **People having Fun:** photos showcasing how you have fun with water in Whatcom County. The possibilities are endless and remember- water takes many forms!
- **Seasons of Water:** photos showcasing water in winter, spring, summer, fall... liquid, ice, snow, fog... be creative!

NEW Category for 2019!

- **Best Water Festival Experience:** photos that best capture the heart and soul of one of the many water-oriented festivals held in Whatcom County... Drayton Harbor Shellebration, Birch Bay Discovery Days, Bellingham SeaFeast, Drayton Harbor Maritime Festival, Whatcom Water Weeks... and more!

How Do I Enter?

1. Submit your photo between August 1 and September 30, 2019 on the WWIN Facebook page.
2. Send an electronic copy of your photo (at full resolution please) to wwinphotocontest@gmail.com.

How Do I Win?

A panel of judges will select a winner from each category. There will also be winners for Fan Favorite, Sponsor Favorite, and Best Camera Phone Photo. These winners are selected from all entries (not category specific). Voting for Fan Favorite will occur on the WWIN Facebook page October 1-October 12. Winners will be notified via email after October 22.

What Do I Win?

Photographers of winning photos from each of the four categories plus the Fan Favorite, Sponsor Favorite, and Best Camera Phone Photo will receive local prizes. Winning photos will also be featured in a 2020 Whatcom Water Week calendar and other Whatcom Water Week promotional materials. All contest participants will be notified when the 2020 calendars are available for pick up.

Contest Rules

- Photos must be taken within Whatcom County.
- Photos must be submitted between August 1, 2019 and September 30, 2019.
- Photos must be submitted by the photographer who took the photo.

- Read and agree to the media/photo release agreement below.
- There is no limit to the number of photos submitted by individuals, but each photo can only be submitted once.
- Each photo must be submitted via the WWIN Facebook page with all required fields filled out.
- Photos that include nudity, profanity or inappropriate behavior or content will be removed from the Facebook page and deemed ineligible for the contest.

WWIN Water Week Photo Contest Media/Photo Release Agreement

I hereby grant the Whatcom Watersheds Information Network (WWIN) and agents of WWIN permission to use my photographs or other digital media that I submitted as an entry/entries to the WWIN photo contest in any and all of their publications, including web-based publications, without payment or other consideration. Authorized use by WWIN or agents of WWIN is limited to non-commercial uses that support WWIN's mission including but not limited to publications, social media, and websites, associated with the agents' organization. I understand that my name will be used to credit my work whenever feasible but giving credit may not always be possible depending on the application.

I accept any liability that may arise from the use of a person's likenesses as my responsibility, with WWIN held blameless for such use.

I understand and agree that all media/photo(s) that are entered into the WWIN photo contest become the property of WWIN and will not be returned and may be used by WWIN and its agents without further notification or permission, and that I retain the ability to use the original image in my own materials or for my own use.

I hereby irrevocably authorize WWIN or its agents to edit, alter, copy, exhibit, publish, and distribute the media/photo(s) that I entered into the WWIN photo contest for any lawful purpose and waive any right to inspect or approve the finished product. Additionally, I waive any right to royalties or other compensation arising or related to the use of the photo.
4. I hereby hold harmless, release, and forever discharge the WWIN from all claims, demands, and causes of action, which I, my heirs, representatives, executors, administrators, or any other persons acting on my behalf or on behalf of my estate have or may have by reason of this authorization.
